

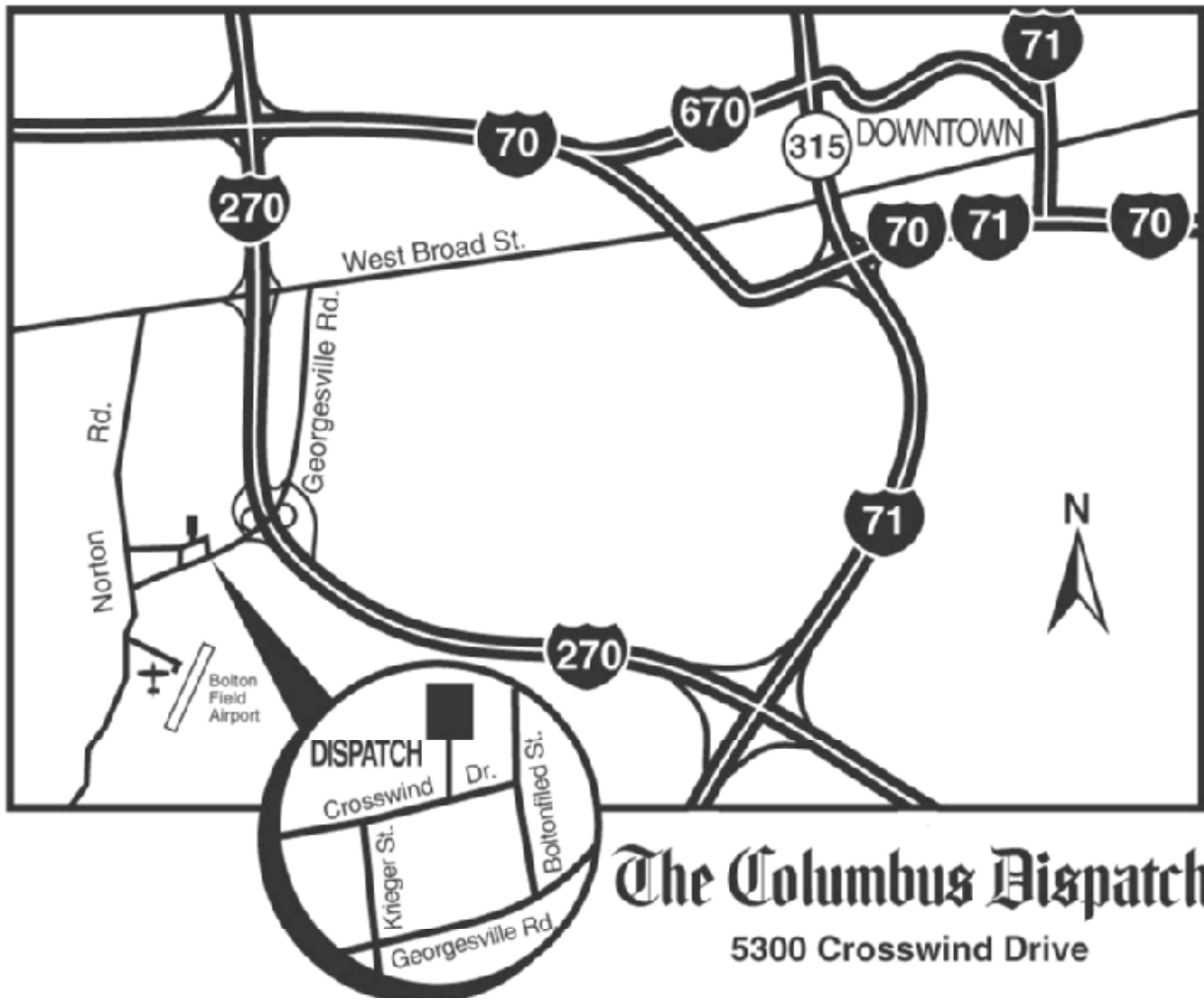
ARMA Columbus Tour of The Columbus Dispatch Production Facility

Jan. 19, we welcome you to The Columbus Dispatch Printing Facility, a 430,000-square-foot, state-of-the-art printing facility on Columbus' West Side. Each day, the reporters, editors and photographers of *The Dispatch* produce their work in the Dispatch building Downtown. At the push of a button, their work is sent via phone lines to the presses 13 miles away, and a small daily miracle begins to unfold. In less than 4 hours, a new issue of *The Dispatch*, the word and paper equivalent of a major novel, will be prepped, printed and put on specific trucks for delivery to 30 central Ohio counties. Our tour will take in the whole process, let you wander among moving robots and past train cars parked *inside* the building, walk you past historic newspaper front pages of the last 100 years, and pause in the \$100 Million Room where the 4 monster presses sit. We look forward to seeing you!

Attendees will need to stop at the security gate before entering the parking lot. We will meet in the Activity Center. This facility is located all the way around behind the production facility. Security will direct you. Registration and coffee & donuts will start at 8:00 and the tour will begin at 8:30 and should be finished by 10:00.
